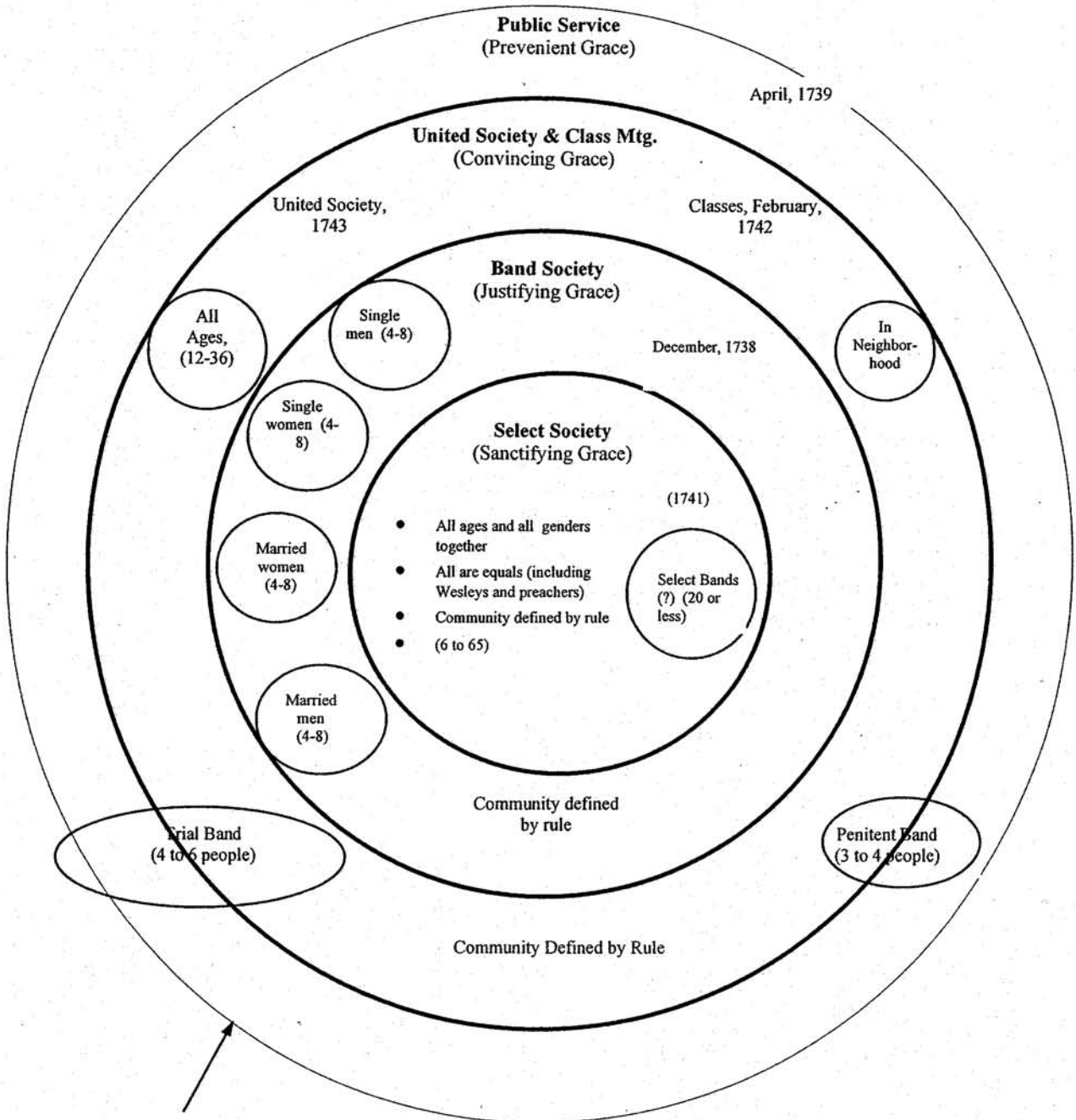


# Overview of the United Society In Early Methodism
